CAN ONE VALLEY HELP REGENERATE THE FUTURE? CORE PREMIERES MUGA GLOBALLY ON JUNE 10 WITH SPECIAL BERLIN SCREENING

POTOMAC, USA and BERLIN, GERMANY - June 10, 2026. Can one valley help regenerate the future? CORE Foundation believes the answer may be yes.

On June 10, CORE will premiere MUGA, a powerful new documentary that follows an ambitious effort to regenerate more than 100,000 hectares across 68 communities in the Muga Valley of Catalonia, Spain. The release coincides with a special screening in Berlin, bringing together environmental leaders, innovators, storytellers, philanthropists, and members of the public for a conversation about regeneration, resilience, and the future of our relationship with nature.

Produced by We Are The Regeneration, MUGA is part of a broader movement dedicated to sharing stories, ideas, and solutions that inspire ecological restoration, community resilience, and a regenerative future for generations to come. Through storytelling, education, and community engagement, the initiative seeks to accelerate awareness and action around regeneration at both local and global scales.

The film will be available globally through CORE's Watch. Learn. Support. initiative, an innovative model that allows audiences to experience meaningful stories while directly supporting the real-world efforts featured in the film.
